

**KNOX COUNTY REGIONAL AIRPORT  
AIRCRAFT PARKING PROGRAM  
Overnight Parking**

Amended September 13, 2005

Transient aircraft parking is only permitted on the main ramp area (northeast of runway 31/13, between taxiways A and B). Aircraft remaining overnight will receive an invoice in the mail, addressed to the registered owner. If the billing should go to a different address airport management must be advised. Bills will be issued on the first day of each month. Aircraft based at Knox County Regional Airport may purchase advance parking passes, on a semi-annual or annual basis, for either the main ramp area or in the remote parking area (between taxiway C and the hangars) based on the availability of tie-down spots.

**OPERATIONAL CONTROL/MONITORING:**

The airport manager is responsible for administering this program. Aircraft will be recorded by tail number (registration) with the opening of the airfield each morning. These aircraft registration numbers will then be entered in the overnight inventory log (via computer), and an invoice will be forwarded to the owner after aircraft has left the airport. Vehicles with combination passes will be parked in the parking lot. If the driver has been trained and the vehicle designated for ramp movement, the vehicle may be parked in place of the aircraft, but in no case will the vehicle remain on the ramp when the aircraft is parked.

**METHOD OF PAYMENT:**

The owner of the aircraft will be billed after the aircraft has left the airport. **Please leave address with FBO of choice.** This requirement is only needed for the first visit. Payment must be by check or cash, unless specific arrangements have been worked out with your FBO.

Pilots may pay by check on day of departure at either FBO – Maine Atlantic Aviation or Downeast Airlines. **Please be sure to include registration number of aircraft on check.** If a receipt is desired, please indicate on the check.

**ADVANCED PURCHASE**

Annual/Semi-annual passes must be purchased in advance. Please forward payment to Knox County Regional Airport Manager, 5 Airport Road, Owls Head, ME 04854. Make checks payable to the Knox County Treasurer. **Be sure to indicate the aircraft registration number on the check.**
