1. It is my pleasure to submit to the Honorable Commissioners the following report regarding the Knox County Jail for the month of **January 2003**
2. Average daily inmate population: **50.39**
3. Average daily pretrial/presentence inmates: **19.55**
4. Average daily sentenced inmates: **30.84**
5. Number of inmates awaiting trial/sentence in excess of 120 days: **1 @ 235**
6. Total revenue from boarded inmates from 01/01/03 to 01/31/03: **\$1,170.00**
7. Average daily boarders: **-.5-**
8. Counties represented by boarders: **Aroostook; Hancock; Lincoln**
9. Total number of inmates hospitalized: **-0-**

14. Miscellaneous: **During this reporting period the administration was compelled to resort to "contingency housing" twice due to a increase in the inmate population. Contingency housing was in effect for 3 days (01/11-13/03) and again for 3 days (01/24-26/03). Three(3) staff were assaulted by inmates and one(1) officer and his family were threatened by an inmate. All these incidents occurred during the admission process and all were referred to the District Attorney for criminal complaints. Due to the significant increase in the inmate population, attributable in large part to stays of execution for the holidays, the meals served during January exceeded projections by 762. This reporting period marks the 2nd highest inmate population in the facility's history. Work on the facility roof has not yet begun.**
