1. It is my pleasure to submit to the Honorable Commissioners the following report regarding the Knox County Jail for the month of July 2003
2. Average daily inmate population: 65.77
3. Average daily pretrial/presentence inmates: 36.55
4. Average daily sentenced inmates: 29.22
5. Number of inmates awaiting trial/sentence in excess of 120 days: 4 [1 @ 229; 1 @ 189; 1 @ 151; 1 @ 124]
6. Total revenue from boarded inmates from 01/01/03 to 07/31/03: \$2,470.00

14. Miscellaneous: During this period contingency housing was opened for 3 days and boarders to other counties increased to a maximum of 17. Inmates were housed at York, Cumberland, Hancock, Somerset, Androscoggin and Piscataquis jails. Board fees INCURRED amounted to approximately \$29,118.60 for the month. An inmate assaulted 2 staff and complaints arising from the assaults were referred to the DA's Office. Another staff member was injured in an accident. This reporting period saw the 6th consecutive month of record breaking inmate population and was the month having the largest inmate population in the history of the facility. During this month mental health clinicians responded to 15 requests from staff for inmate crisis assessments and one 1-on-1 suicide watch had to be initiated. To date, meals served exceed the annual projections by 4,493.
