2. Average daily inmate population: 58.65
3. Average daily pretrial/presentence inmates: 22.94

Miscellaneous: The inmate population during this reporting period was the highest in the history of the facility and was the 4<sup>th</sup> consecutive month for record-breaking inmate population. It was necessary to resort to contingency housing for 3 days and to board out an additional 4 inmates at Somerset County from 05/16/03 for a total of 8 inmates boarded out per day since 05/16/03. Total boarding fees INCURRED by the County during May amounted to \$15,550. The corrections divisions in Lincoln, Knox and Waldo counties will participate in research project funded by the State to explore jail diversion. \$65K has been awarded for the project and the money appears to be dedicated to personnel services. Mental health clinicians responded to twelve(12) staff requests for assessments or interventions with inmates during this reporting period.
