14. Miscellaneous: **Population records were broken again for the 9th consecutive month and meals served during this reporting period exceeded projections year-to-date by 5,915. It is expected that budget line #608-5104 will be overdrawn during November, a direct consequence of the dramatic increase in the inmate population. During October contingency housing was initiated for 3 days and an average of 8 inmates were boarded out each day during the reporting period representing average daily board fees incurred of \$800.00 or \$24,800.00 for the month. Clinicians from Mid-Coast Mental Health Center conducted 22 crisis assessments at the request of staff and 2 suicide watches were conducted. The staff injury was incurred while attempting to control a violent inmate.**
