1. It is my pleasure to submit to the Honorable Commissioners the following report regarding the Knox County Jail for the month of **September 2003**
2. Average daily inmate population: **60.73**
3. Average daily pretrial/presentence inmates: **25.7**
4. Average daily sentenced inmates: **35.03**
5. Number of inmates awaiting trial/sentence in excess of 120 days: **3 [1 @ 186; 1 @ 145; 1 @ 131]**
6. Total revenue from boarded inmates from 01/01/03 to 09/30/03: **\$2,470**
7. Average daily boarders: **-0-**

9. Total number of inmates hospitalized: **-1-**

14. Miscellaneous: **The agency continued to set inmate population records for the 8th consecutive month, marking the record for the same reporting period, quarter and year-to-date. The increased population resulted in boarding out inmates every day during the reporting period. The increased population resulted in 5,380 meals served in excess of projections [year-to-date]. The inmate hospitalization was occasioned by a mental health commitment ["blue paper"]. During that commitment the staff at the Augusta Mental Health Institute appeared to be uncooperative in the extreme and resulted in occupying 2 transport officers for approximately 15 hours and 2 round trips to AMHI.**
